



Hangar Tenants Topics for this Month July 8, 2017

1. Minimum Standards and Rules and Regulations

- a. These are posted on our website
- b. Will go into effect with new leases this year.
- c. Please review prior so if you have questions, we can address at the meeting
- d. If you want to continue to have airport access to the non-movement areas of SBY Regional Airport, our Airport Familiarization and Driving Test will also be administered when your lease is renewed. New access keys will be provided at that time. All others keys will be deactivated.

2. Hangar Status - Old T-Hangars and New T-Hangars

- a. Removal of the first 2 hangars is complete
- b. The 3rd hangars' removal will be begin the second week of July.
- c. New T-Hangar Row- T-Hangars (14 T-Hangars) and w/one or two free-span– bid will be out for proposals. Then cost per month will be determined once awarded.
- d. Also, the 3 existing T-Hangar will be renovated and the taxiway's replaced (approximately \$200K for paving and \$ for roof repairs and painting)
- e. Taxiway B South construction will begin in Sept. which may coincide with the hangar and taxiway project -
- f. Once bids are received the MX surcharge will be added to each T-Hangar lease. The money amount will be dedicated to the MX of your hangars



- g. New Waiting list for Hangars is now available. The options are for current tenant have first priority and then new tenants second priority. There will be plenty of options for everyone.
3. Hanger 7 and Bay Lands Hangar are being evaluated for maintenance and up- grading (painting, and ramp work, etc.)
4. Possible Fly-In on OCT 7th is being planned. More details as they become available- The Theme is Emergencies and being prepared for anything while flying.
